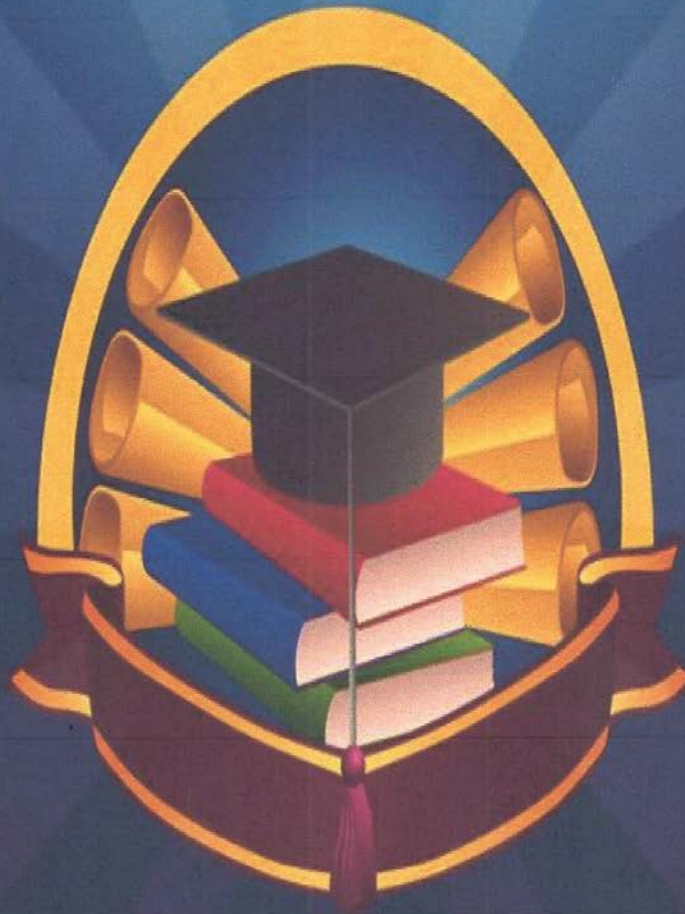

I beseech you to petition God for His direction regarding the institute and I sincerely believe He will speak to your spirit regarding the importance of the upcoming course of study.

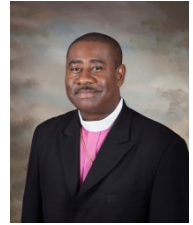
