

Course Title: Sound Doctrine 2 – 7 Credits

Prerequisite: Sound Doctrine 1 Approximate Length: 12 Sessions

Course Objective:

The objective of this course is to examine the basis for the doctrine of the Cape Fear & Southwestern Free Will Baptist Conference. The term paper should be related to Free Will Baptist doctrine or a related subject or an instructor-approved topic. The term paper is due two weeks prior to the end of the semester.




